ENERGY STAR® MANUFACTURED HOME REBATE- NEW OR REPLACEMENT HOMES

Program Participation Guidelines

NEW HOMES THAT QUALIFY FOR A REBATE

- New Manufactured homes with a permanently installed forced air electric furnace or heat pump.
- Must have been designed, constructed, and certified by Northwest Energy Efficient Manufactured (NEEM) Homes program as Energy Star compliant.

REPLACEMENT HOMES THAT QUALIFY FOR A REBATE

- Existing home must have been built prior to 1976.
- Existing home must be electrically heated.
- Existing home must be occupied as a residence.
- Existing home must be decommissioned and disposed of and may not be used as a dwelling once the new NEEM home is sited.
- Replacement homes must be new, electrically heated, and NEEM certified as a NEEM 1.1 or 2.0 Home.

REBATE AMOUNT

- \$1200 for New NEEM 1.1 Certified Homes
- \$1400 for New NEEM 2.0 Certified Homes
- \$2200 for Replacement of Pre-1976 Home with NEEM 1.1 Certified Home
- \$2500 for Replacement of Pre-1976 Home with NEEM 2.0 Certified Home

***Rebate(s) will not exceed 100% of total installed cost**

BEFORE INSTALLATION: PRE-APPROVAL

- An on-site visit is *not* required prior to installation to qualify for the rebate.
- Rebate Applications must be submitted within six (6) months of purchase/installation to qualify.

AFTER INSTALLATION: FINAL DOCUMENTATION (NEW HOMES)

- Signed ENERGY STAR® Manufactured Home Rebate Application
- Northwest Energy Efficient Manufactured (NEEM) Homes ENERGY STAR qualified compliance certificate
- **All required documentation must be included with application for rebate to be paid.**

AFTER INSTALLATION: FINAL DOCUMENTATION (REPLACEMENT HOMES)

- Signed ENERGY STAR® Manufactured Home rebate application
- Northwest Energy Efficient Manufactured (NEEM) Homes ENERGY STAR qualified compliance certificate
- Completed BPA Manufactured Home Replacement Project Information Form
- Documentation that the original home was constructed prior to 1976 in the form of one of the following:
 - A copy of the home's title
 - A copy of the home's data plate showing the date of construction
 - A completed BPA Documentation of Pre-HUD Construction form signed by the utility
 - Another pre-approved BPA method
 - Completed documentation of Manufactured Home Decommissioning Form signed by the utility
 - **All required documentation must be included with application for rebate to be paid.**

REBATE PAYMENTS

- Please allow 6-8 weeks for payment after receipt of all required documentation.
- All rebates will be paid in the form of a credit to an active CCEC member account.
- Please ensure to specify the correct account number in your application to where credit should be applied.
